INSTRUCTIONS

Welcome to the Undercliffe Cemetery Mini Beast Safari. Follow the trail around the Cemetery and look in each habitat for different types of Mini Beast. As you find them mark them off on your Tick Chart.

SMALL HUNTERS CODE OF CONDUCT

Please catch your Mini Beast gently.
Don't cause any damage.
Put back any logs and stones you move.
After you have looked at your Mini Beast
PLEASE let it go.

- 1) A Bare and Barren Habitat. The Historical Core has no grass or plants, could there still be life here?
- 2) Lovely Long Grass! Plunge in, part the stems and see what you can find.
- 3) The Great Cemetery Barrier. Have a look along the bottom of the wall and carefully examine every nook and cranny. What lives in a wall?
- 4) Short Grass in the quiet and secluded Quaker Burial ground. Do smaller insects live in shorter grass?
- 5) A Bank covered in bushes. It's cool, dark and damp. Look in the leaf litter and the top layer of soil.
- 6) Ecological Corner and Mini Beast paradise. Look in the log piles and under the stones. Please put everything back, it's their world too.
