

Undercliffe Cemetery, Bradford

Plots available at this prestigious cemetery



Location: Undercliffe Cemetery is a beautiful 26-acre burial ground situated to the north of Bradford, bounded by Otley Road, Undercliffe Lane and Undercliffe Old Road. Set on a hill, there are panoramic views over the city including the football ground and Lister's Mill, and to the countryside beyond. It is one of the country's finest Victorian cemeteries, and has been called the 'Highgate of the North'.

New Plots Available: Undercliffe Cemetery has been in continuous use for burials since 1854, and currently offers new plots for interments and ashes as well as the re-opening of family graves. In addition, the Lodge at the Undercliffe Lane entrance is available for hire for smaller funeral gatherings and other events by arrangement. It is run by the Undercliffe Cemetery Charity, supported by Bradford Council. Our Business Manager & Registrar, Andrew Barker, is based at the Lodge.

Access: There is a convenient car park adjacent to the Lodge. The layout of the Cemetery allows vehicular access to the main areas and there is level access to the Lodge which has toilets and a kitchen area.
