Harrison had three siblings.

Harrison attended Bradford Grammar School before entering the family business. At the time of the 1911 Census Harrison was to be found in a boarding house in

Bournemouth along with his mother and sister Margery, who is described as having "private means". By this time the family had moved to St Mary's Road in Manningham.

The England & Wales National Probate Calendar for 1917 shows that Storey left effects to the value of £496 6s 2d. which was paid to his father Thomas Henry Storey. This document also informs us that Harrison Leetham Storey died on 12 September 1917 at Roehampton Convalescent Hospital in Surrey.

Second Lieutenant Harrison Leethem Storey who died on Tuesday 12 September 1916 in Roehampton Convalescent Hospital in Surrey at the age of 22, was the son of Thomas Henry and Harriet Martha Storey.

He was born in March 1894 in Shipley into a successful family. His father was an Export Stuff Merchant and according to the 1911 Census Harrison listed his occupation as Cloth Merchants Assistant, suggesting he had entered the family business.

A measure of the family's success is the fact that in 1901 when living in Ivy Road, Shipley their household included a servant and a Governess
